The Greater Bay Area – Leveraging Opportunities for Hong Kong in the Transition towards Sustainability

23 May 2018

Business Environment Council (BEC) held its flagship EnviroSeries Conference on 23 May 2018, focusing on business opportunities that will arise from the green transition of the Greater Bay Area (GBA). Share and collaborate piloting projects to leverage regional and international opportunities



Focus on areas to add value on or take the lead within the GBA to get a "seat at the table" in terms of regional policy making
