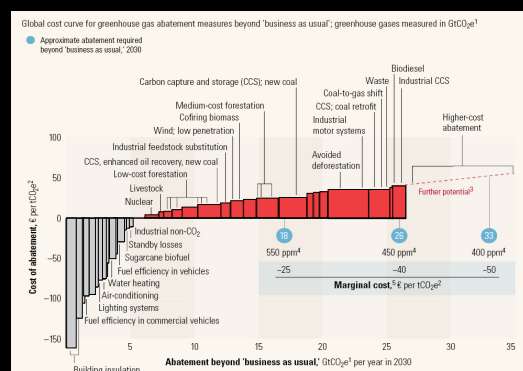


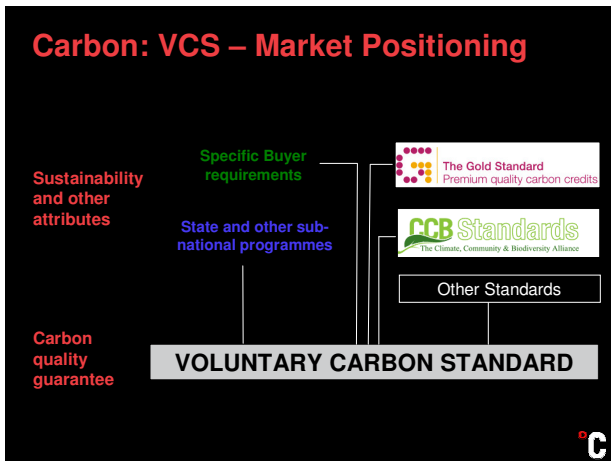
IPCC Fourth Assessment Report

- Radiative forcing from CO₂ increased 20% from 1995 to 2005
- Future warming will happen
 - Low scenario 1.8° C (1.1° C to 2.9° C),
 - High scenario 4.0° C (2.4° C to 6.4° C)
- The last time the polar regions were warmer than present (125,000 years ago), sea level was 4 to 6 meters higher.
- Snow cover is projected to contract. Widespread increases in thaw depth are projected over most permafrost regions.
- Sea ice is projected to shrink under all scenarios.
- Very likely that hot extremes, heat waves, and heavy precipitation events will continue to become more frequent.
- Likely that future tropical cyclones (typhoons and hurricanes) will become more intense
- Extra-tropical storm tracks are projected to move poleward, continuing trends
- Increases in precipitation are very likely in high-latitudes, while decreases are likely in most subtropical regions (by as much as 20%) continuing recent trends.
