The Forest Stewardship Council® (FSCTM) certification is one of the certification systems that endorse timber harvested from a responsible source.

This seminar, co-organised with **BEAM Society Limited**, gives you the essential knowledge of sustainable forest management, FSC certification and certified products, as well as the assessment criteria for related BEAM Plus credits.
