The guidebook aims to facilitate event organisers and related stakeholders in formulating waste management strategies, achieving waste reduction and enhancing environmental performance.

BEC hosts the "Energy Efficient Retrofit Guide & Calculator - Launch Event"



BEC launched its "Guide to Energy Efficient Retrofits of Office and Hotel Buildings: identifying cost effective solutions" and "Retrofit Calculator" on 12 Dec at BEC Auditorium. The Retrofit Guide and Calculator are the outputs of a project funded by KAS foundation and supported by the HKSAR Government, offering buildings owners, managers and tenants information to enable decisions on retrofitting existing buildings and in developing the business case to do so.

The Retrofit Guide provides a description of those mature energy efficient technologies that will help achieve significant carbon/energy savings and explains the approximate net costs and the payback periods for various options. It focuses on existing commercial buildings, namely offices and hotels. Information is provided in a visually simple and easy to use format to support both technical and non-technical personnel in their decision-making.

The Retrofit Calculator is an easy-to-use excel tool designed to estimate the costs and energy saving performance of individual technologies and initiatives for specific buildings with user-customized specifications.

BEC Industry Visit to Chemical Waste Treatment Facilities



On 14 Dec, BEC's members and friends went to the Chemical Waste Treatment Facilities (CMTF) operated by Ecospace Limited, a wholly-owned subsidiary of BEC Corporate Member Veolia, where all land-based chemical waste, clinical waste and marine pollutants (MARPOL waste) generated from ocean-going and local vessels in Hong Kong are managed.

BEC IEE, Hong Kong Centre for Carbon Innovation ("HKCCI") and University of Edinburgh ("UoE") co-organised a half day Executive Training on Developing and Financing Low Carbon Economy on 13 Dec.
