BEC Industry Visit to Baguio Green Group and K. Wah Construction Materials at EcoPark

On 24 May, around 30 guests joined BEC’s Industry Visit to two BEC member sites. The first was the Waste Glass Bottle Recycling Plant of Baguio Green Group which features an advanced glass recycling technology with a processing capacity of 100 tonnes per day. Then, the tour moved to K. Wah Construction Materials which collects the glass cullet produced by Baguio and mixes it with other construction and demolition waste to form new pavers. Participants gained a deeper understanding on the entire production chain of eco-blocks and eco-pavers, which are environment-friendly, decorative and functional.
