BEC SUSTAINABILITY REPORT 2019

BEC has published Sustainability Report 2019, our third biennial sustainability report, describing how BEC works with over 200 corporate members, stakeholders and the wider community to enable sustainability, enhance environmental performance and contribute to the transition to a low carbon economy in Hong Kong. In fiscal year 2017-18 and 2018-19, BEC delivered:

- 348 environmental projects
- 155 community engagement activities
- 9 policy submissions

- 43% reduction in BEC Building's greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions *
- 31% reduction in BEC Building's energy consumption *
 - * Compare to the baseline year (FY 2012-13)

The report covers how BEC is an enabler within the sustainability ecosystem working to deliver value to our members, drive government and business action, and demonstrate leadership using BEC Building as a "Green Lab". Furthermore, it assesses the impact of BEC's initiatives to determine opportunities where it can contribute to the concerted efforts to meet the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), emphasising SDG 4: Quality Education and SDG 17: Partnerships for the Goals. The report reinforces BEC's commitment to drive positive sustainable change in Hong Kong guided by the 3 organisational strategic priorities. BEC will continue to leverage its expertise to support and advise companies in Hong Kong to reach the forefront of global sustainability trends. Demonstrating leadership in Hong Kong's journey to a net-zero carbon future is core to BEC's organisational objectives, therefore, BEC plans to commit to a long-term decarbonisation strategy which includes plans for setting BEC's own carbon reduction target and strategy.

To promote sustainability, HK Electric has committed to "Energy Saving Charter" and "4T Charter" promulgated by EMSD and has been implementing best practices for its office, such as using energy-efficient equipment and smart lighting control; switching off lights during lunch time; and using electric vehicles and water efficient appliances.

The Company also promotes waste-free and waste reduction culture by centralising rubbish bins in the office; collecting food waste and donating unconsumed food; and encouraging recycling of glass bottle, printer cartridge/tonner and rechargeable battery on top of paper, plastic and metal at office. Moreover, digitalising work process such as e-procurement, e-tendering helps reduce office paper consumption.

Common office recyclables like paper, plastic bottles, aluminium cans, batteries, discs and cartridges are regularly collected and recycled. The light-brown recycle bins are specially designed by a local green group and made from recycled wood in order to give a second life to the wood waste. Trapezium-shaped, the recycle bins can fit together like puzzle pieces to give a chill and green look.

BEC Corporate Member **Arup** published an article on the future of transport resilience changed by the COVID-19 pandemic, exploring the advantages, current adoption and challenges ahead of a robust future-oriented public commuting system. Driven by a host of emerging technologies, such a future will feature connected and autonomous vehicles (CAVs) that are constantly fed with real-time data that can detect, predict and react to surrounding environment and road users' behaviours, making it compatible to execute smarter and safer driving manoeuvres. Its self-driving pods can also deliver daily necessities to households, commute to supermarkets or conduct inspections via robots at hospitals, minimising human contact and exposure to health risks, and ensuring commuting behaviour becomes more manageable. The article also cited some trial examples around the world and the challenges encountered.
