BEC's New Recycling Facilities



As Hong Kong's green lab, BEC has recently installed a beverage carton recycling bin at the entrance of BEC Building to encourage our staff and all users of the building to separate their waste for recycling, adding to a wide range of existing collection bins for waste paper, plastics, metals, glass containers and ink cartridges.

With the growing attention towards environmental protection, electric vehicles (EVs) have become a major trend. BEC Council Member Schneider Electric now supports more than 500 EV charging stations across 28 locations in Hong Kong, including residential estates, shopping malls, hospitals and commercial buildings. BEC Council Member Swire Properties had its Science-Based Targets (SBT) officially approved – making the company the first developer from Hong Kong and Mainland China to establish long-term decarbonisation goals for its portfolios around the world, that are in line with the Paris Agreement. Swire Properties will reduce their greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions in accordance with the approved targets, which include reducing scope 1 and 2 GHG emissions per square metre by 35% by 2025 and 52% by 2030; as well as reducing scope 3 GHG emissions from downstream leased assets and capital goods by 28% and 25% respectively by 2030. In order to meet these ambitious targets, Swire Properties will have to continuously adopt innovative low-carbon technologies and management best practices to further enhance the energy efficiency of their global building stock. They will also work closely with their tenants and supply chain partners to reduce carbon emissions along their value chain.

And as part of its corporate social responsibility, HK Electric has been implementing four community programmes on elderly care and green education, all of which have been up and running for more than 10 years.

It replaces manual data entry by linking various digital systems, auto-capturing data and bill images to export them into corresponding task in iESG, thus streamlining the overall flow of iESG data entry and consolidation process. Committed to achieving United Nations Sustainable Development Goals, Fuji Xerox (Hong Kong) will continue to create value for customers and other stakeholders and deliver as promised to create a better world for future generations.

BEC General Member **Active Energy Management (AEM)** recently investigated a District Cooling Scheme experiencing unpredictable pump efficiency, air and cavitation problems risking pump erosion, excess energy costs and short life, and thus representing poor sustainability. AEM's condition-monitoring regime used multi-axis vibration monitoring and

innovative microphonic acoustic signature measurement to track pump degradation. Investigating negative head pumping yielded options for periodic impeller and casing repairs using elastomeric casing linings and hard impeller coatings. This assured lifecycle outlook and avoided high-cost system modifications, including environmentally wasteful major replacement of pipelines.

The company explores new business opportunities by using its ample printing experience and capabilities to create new displays and exhibition panels. BEC General Member **Royal Grand Tech Company.**, **Ltd (RGT)** has started to supply a water-saving hygienic washcloth to more than 13 departments of a Macau hospital since October. In fact, RGT became the first nanotech company in Hong Kong to apply this technology in the medical field when they started supplying the washcloth to a medical management group based in Guangdong province last year. Moreover, RGT has begun to cooperate with a local hotel by supplying anti-polluting glass coating products since November. RGT also helped the hotel achieve indoor energy saving and reduce the indoor temperature by 3°C.



BEC General Member **Tony Ip Green Architects (TiP)** recently completed two avantgarde projects at CIC-Zero Carbon Park. Being the first of its kind in Hong Kong, emMiC Stormwater Air-Conditioning System makes use of stormwater as an alternative cooling and heating medium to provide a more energy efficient air conditioning system. By adopting nano-technology, Air Improvement Photovoltaic (AIPV) Glass Canopy generates renewable energy with diffuse daylight, decomposes PM2.5 pollutants and facilitates self-cleansing simultaneously. At the tipping point of climate change, TiP will strive to advocate the paradigm shift to green architecture and biophilic urban-scape.

BEC General Member **Vitasoy** has begun a pilot education scheme on clean recycling of beverage cartons, linking up over 80 local and international schools and estates. The scheme started with school education including placement of recycling bins, a series of eco talks and Green Captain project. Meanwhile, Hong Kong's first Carton Recycling Mobile Education Centre started touring around the city to engage the community by housing panels to display knowledge about

clean recycling of beverage cartons. It also serves as a pop-up collection point for cartons.

Designated recycling bins made of chipboard recycled from beverage cartons have been placed in schools and communities for regular collection of cartons, which will be processed at Mil Mill, the first pulp mill that recycles beverage cartons in Hong Kong. Hong Kong's first Beverage Carton Sustainability Education Centre was also established there for people to learn about clean carton recycling, circular economy and sustainable forest.
