BEC ENVIROSERIES CONFERENCE

More than 200 business leaders, entrepreneurs, innovators and academics participated in the BEC EnviroSeries Conference on 8 July entitled "Business Sustainability in the midst of Disruption, Turbulence and Recovery". Twenty prominent speakers and panellists shared their insights and proposed innovative, low carbon strategies for a sustainable post-COVID-19 recovery for businesses and organisations.

In her keynote speech, Dr María Mendiluce, CEO of We Mean Business coalition, emphasised that climate crisis would not wait for recovery from COVID-19 and that green recovery makes business sense as taking climate action would benefit both the economy and people. Mr Richard Lancaster, Chairman of BEC, added that businesses need to take a long-term view and focus on sustainability to prepare for unexpected challenges and increase resilience. While our major focus at present is battling the pandemic, he said it is important for us not to lose sight of the equally-urgent challenge of climate change.

BEC Council Member **Airport Authority Hong Kong (AAHK)** is transitioning its airside vehicles, including airside passenger and staff buses, from diesel to electric powered as a carbon reduction initiative. These newly introduced e-buses not only can boast zero emissions, but also are equipped with 200km driving range and short charging time. It is planned that the e-bus fleet size will increase from the current 16 to 25 in the coming year, and eventually to over 40 by 2024.

The opening of O·PARK1, Hong Kong's first organic resources recovery centre at Siu Ho Wan on Lantau Island, which was designed, built and now operated by ATAL, has marked a new milestone on the city's journey to turn food waste into renewable energy. Advanced anaerobic digestion and composting technologies are applied to convert food waste from restaurants and food factories into biogas for power generation, enabling the Centre to treat up to 73,000 tonnes of food waste annually.

In addition to regular recycling of paper, waste and plastic, Fung Group has also collaborated with a leading footwear and apparel company to collect their clothes hangers which amounted to the bulk of their wasted created. These initiatives are prompting other businesses to further expand the scope of the recycling materials from being dumped into our landfill sites.



Being plastic-free is one of the long-standing goals in BEC Corporate Member Hong Kong Air Cargo Terminals Limited's (Hactl) "Green Terminal" programme. Hactl has set up visually attractive orange "Water Spots" installed with 81 water dispensers in various locations throughout SuperTerminal 1. To reduce plastic waste by cutting at source, Hactl encourages its staff to bring their own water bottles instead of purchasing bottled water by setting up these "Water Spots".

Ten units have been deployed in Hong Kong over the past few months replacing 14 diesel generators. This is equivalent to taking 2,800 cars off the roads of Hong Kong in terms of air quality pollutants. As a connected device, Ampd Enertainer provides valuable data insights to contractors and developers too.





Committed to building a sustainable environment, BEC General Member Cornerstone EV Charging Service Limited, through its sister company, has been placing more and more reverse vending machines in the community for plastic drinking bottle recycling. In July 2020, 9 machines have been introduced at different spots in Central and Western District. The company also actively thinks of creative ways to encourage the public to participate in waste separation and sorting, which is pivotal in the Government's waste reduction strategy.



BEC General Member **Mayer Brown** partner Angela Yim and senior associate Phoebe Fok authored an article entitled "Safety First: More Required on ESG from Directors and Officers in Hong Kong". The amended Hong Kong Stock Exchange Environment, Social and Governance Reporting Guide ("Guide"), which aims at enhancing workplace safety, comes into effect on 1 July 2020. Under the Guide, previously recommended disclosures on social matters are made compulsory and listed companies are required to disclose KPI in different occupational health and safety areas. The Guide also upgraded the disclosure obligation to a "comply or explain" basis, meaning that listed companies must report on the required KPI or provide reasons for non-disclosure.
