


WEBINAR: OPPORTUNITIES FOR CIRCULAR ECONOMY IN HONG KONG

We had an exciting and informative discussion at the "Opportunities for Circular Economy in Hong Kong" webinar on 8 March. A big thank you to all speakers and panellists for sharing their insights on why a circular economy is important and how Hong Kong can become a more circular city. The panellists agreed that there is a need to set up a high-level, cross-bureaux working group on the circular economy for better collaboration across the government to deliver circularity. They also suggested that the Waste Blueprint for Hong Kong 2035 needs to place greater emphasis on aspects crucial to a circular economy, such as design, repair, reuse, remanufacturing and alternative business models to facilitate a more holistic transition from a linear economy.

The webinar also featured a presentation on the findings from BEC's "Circularity Assessment of Hong Kong" report.

New BEC Low Carbon Charter Initiative

With Hong Kong's 2050 carbon neutrality pledge and the anticipation of accelerated transition towards a low-carbon economy in the post-COVID-19 era, scaling up climate action is more important than ever.

To strengthen support for over 70 BEC Low Carbon Charter signatories and the wider business community, BEC is pleased to introduce new initiatives to address sectoral decarbonisation challenges!



In September 2020, the Development Bureau announced that all public work contracts issued on or after 1 February 2021 must apply for temporary electricity and water supply to take advantage of a great emission reduction opportunity in the construction industry. Riding on the policy change, BEC, partnering with Council Member Gammon Construction Limited, is taking a step further to launch a new initiative under the Charter called the "Power Up Coalition" which aims to advocate and promote the use of electricity in private and semi-private construction sites. The coalition will launch in April with a series of events addressing the practical challenges of electrifying construction sites. Refer below for details of the launch workshop!

Webinar: Designing Zero Waste Food Places



To encourage customers to live a greener life and promote a low-carbon diet, Chinachem is partnered with 13 of its F&B tenants to kick off the "NINA MALL GO GREEN" scheme on 10 March. The scheme will run until 7 April during which participating restaurants will offer green menu options every Wednesday. This scheme is expected to reduce 3 tonnes of carbon dioxide emissions!

Hongkong Land was awarded the IFMA Asia Pacific Awards of Excellence 2020 -Innovation Award in March for its implementation of an Integrated Smart Management System (ISMS) into property management operations, as part of continuous efforts to introduce various system enhancements and novel initiatives. The implementation of the ISMS brought multiple benefits including energy saving through AI system optimisation, reduction of labour on system monitoring, enhancement of operation efficiency and reliability, and service improvements with increased thermal comfort and customer satisfaction.



To help staff develop a beverage cartons recycling habit, Modern Terminals Limited has placed two designated recycling bins in its office area since January. It is a result of a successful two-month Beverage Carton Redemption Scheme from which a total of 5,562 cartons were collected and delivered to a local recycler for conversion into paper pulp. The initiative is now a permanent fixture of Modern Terminals Limited's recycling practice.

Swire Properties has been collaborating with a tech start-up to launch Hong Kong's first smart reusable cup network at Taikoo Place as part of the company's efforts to conserve resources and promote circularity. Launched last November with 2 eateries, the network welcomed 3 more outlets this March. The concept is simple: borrow a cup, enjoy your coffee, return the cup, get another one – all powered by a mobile app. Over the past 5 months, over 4,200 single-use cups have been saved from landfills.

In February, **The Hong Kong Jockey Club** released its *Standing Strong Together* documentary to highlight the Club's initiatives to support its employees, members and the Hong Kong community during the COVID-19 pandemic. Featuring over 20 interviews, the documentary highlights the Club's commitment to sustain racing amid the pandemic in order to contribute to society and safeguard the welfare of its employees. The route is the latest addition to 10 others under the "Green Hong Kong Green" programme, which encourages the public to appreciate local eco-heritage resources and treasure the environment. As part of the long-term plan to electrify its fleet of ground service equipment, **Hong Kong Air Cargo Terminals Limited (Hactl)** replaced an ageing diesel-powered passenger stair with an electric one in late 2020 with a view to minimise air pollution and reduce carbon emissions in its operations.



Growing demand for vehicle ownership, traffic congestion, severe air pollution and increasing dependence on imported fuel pose tough environmental challenges to Vietnam. To support the country's green transport and low-carbon city development and help fulfil its commitment to a 25% GHG emissions reduction by 2030, **Arup** was commissioned by the World Bank earlier this year to develop an electric mobility (e-mobility) roadmap to scale up Vietnam's electric vehicle deployment and facilitate the uptake of renewable energy. The company will also formulate strategies to support industry engagement in the e-mobility ecosystem and advise the Vietnamese government on institutional integration and capacity development around digitalisation.

Earning this accolade reaffirms SGS's commitment to deliver sustainable values to society and enable a better, safer and more interconnected world.

To demonstrate how local car parks can be more EV-ready, **Cornerstone EV Charging Service Limited** installed the Load Management System (LMS) in Kwai Fong Car Park where 94 EV chargers are available as of March. Optimising the power supply to ensure efficiency, LMS enables more EV chargers to be installed and used at the same time without having to increase the electricity load. **Click HERE to learn more**



To provide a more convenient and efficient way to recycle, **Crown Gas Stoves** launched a door-to-door recycling service under the iRecycle programme of fellow BEC member Baguio in 2020 and collected over 9,300 glass and 28,000 plastic containers in the past 6 months. Even while staying in during the COVID-19 pandemic, registered users may still recycle glass and plastic containers by making an appointment by phone or WhatsApp for collection. After recycling, users can earn iDollars and redeem gifts at select green merchants.



DSG Energy received a certificate from Shell in March for joining its nature-based solutions project to offset carbon dioxide emissions and further build sustainability in business practices. By the end of 2020, over 80% of the company's vehicles in operation were fuelled by biodiesel, which results in fewer greenhouse gas emissions than other available fossil fuels. **Click HERE to learn more**
