RETHINK HK 2025

BEC was pleased to be the exclusive co-organiser of ReThink HK 2025, held on 11-12 September at the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre. Marking our fifth consecutive year of partnership, this year's event once again brought together sustainability leaders to drive impactful conversations and solutions.

As part of the event, BEC hosted BEC Climate and Nature Theatre, featuring two days of insightful discussions and knowledge sharing. On Day 1, the programme focused on "Climate, Nature and Accelerating Corporate Action", exploring how businesses can accelerate climate and nature integration through corporate strategies, technology and partnerships.





Our Day 2 programme shifted focus with the theme "The Future is Blue and Green: Solutions & Opportunities", turning discussions into actionable solutions for the blue and green economies. Key topics included nature financing, TNFD reporting frameworks, and scalable marine solutions. The sessions also examined how climate tech can strengthen ecological and economic resilience across various sectors, merging global perspectives with Hong Kong's local context.

An interactive workshop was also held, where participants explored the intersection of climate science and supply chain operations. Through hands-on activities and discussions, attendees addressed critical areas such as water management, waste reduction, and biodiversity preservation.

BEC Chairman Mr Kevin O'Brien and CEO Mr Simon Ng joined the VIP tour, visiting booths to learn about the sustainability initiatives and future strategies of participating companies. A key highlight was BEC Pavilion, where delegates engaged with BEC Members showcasing cutting-edge products and services. Their innovation and leadership continue to shape Hong Kong's journey towards a net-zero future.

BEC CEO Dialogue: Strategies for Social and Environmental Sustainability in Building Community Resilience





He joined BEC CEO Mr Simon Ng for an insightful exchange on strategies for driving sustainability in the insurance industry and strengthening community resilience in Hong Kong and beyond.

Green Performance Pledge Workshop at ReThink 2025 – Beyond Carbon: Exploring the Water Cycle, Water-Climate Nexus and Hidden Water Footprints in Sustainability



As part of the Green Performance Pledge ("GPP") Academy programme, an engaging workshop at ReThink 2025 brought together 32 participants from 23 companies to highlight the critical yet often overlooked role of water in sustainability. Swire Properties' GPP drives joint action towards shared goals, with this session placed "water" at the centre of the conversation, showing its deep connections with climate, ecosystems, and biodiversity.

Facilitated by Joyce Wong, Founder of Better Futures, and Basel Kirmani, Managing Director of Turquoise Sustainability, the workshop created a lively and interactive setting. It began with a light skit and introductions, followed by a quiz to guide participants in reflecting their understanding on Hong Kong's water tariffs, consumption and management. Participants also explored the concept of the water footprint, including invisible water use embedded in food, transport, and technology. A creative game on the natural water cycle then brought to life the flows between oceans, rivers, soil, plants, and people. The exercise highlighted how water sustains biodiversity and human communities, and how climate change is disrupting these delicate balances. The collaborative activities encouraged meaningful conversations about the local and global realities of water insecurity.

The workshop motivated participants to develop deeper appreciation of water as a cornerstone of sustainable living. They reflected on practical actions, from reducing their personal water footprints to promoting water-savvy choices in daily life and supporting resilient policies. The workshop inspired ideas for partnerships that integrate responsible water management into long-term strategies, and ultimately underscored that water is not only an environmental concern but a foundation of sustainability. In recent years, Hong Kong's energy development has focused on achieving net-zero power generation and increasing the share of renewable energy, actively aligning with the national "3060 Dual Carbon Targets" and striving towards carbon neutrality. Mainland China's new energy industry is rapidly advancing, with technologies such as new energy vehicles, battery storage, and intelligent equipment becoming increasingly mature and widely adopted across industries.

BEC will be organising the energy transition tour to Nanjing and Liyang, Jiangsu between 13 and 16 October 2025. Council Members

Airport Authority Hong Kong ("AAHK") has granted over HK\$16 million to 16 projects in FY2025/26, under its independent Marine Ecology Enhancement Fund ("MEEF") and Fisheries Enhancement Fund ("FEF"). Managed and run by universities, research organisations and associations from the fisheries industry, the funded projects will support efforts such as tracking the potential distribution of the critically endangered Chinese Bahaba in Hong Kong western waters, analysing fishery landscapes and population health of a depleted seascape, and enhancing the local fishery resources through scientific release and breeding of fish fry. AAHK's MEEF and FEF aim to enhance marine environment and fisheries resources, having granted approximately HK\$112 million to projects since their establishment in 2016.

CLP has pledged its full support for the 15th National Games, the 12th National Games for Persons with Disabilities, and the 9th National Special Olympic Games (Hong Kong) to be held in November and December. CLP will enable the use of zero-carbon electricity across all competition and operation venues in Hong Kong through the purchase of Renewable Energy Certificates. It will also provide Battery Energy Storage System units for on-site electric vehicle charging at the main media centre and beach volleyball event venue. In addition, power banks will be offered to athletes, technical officials and media personnel for portable charging. CLP will further sponsor tickets for grass-roots families and underprivileged groups, enabling them to experience the excitement of the events. CLP's volunteers will also take part in various roles during the Games to actively contribute to this national sports event.



Hang Lung Properties is driving sustainable construction forward by procuring 1,200 tonnes of low carbon emissions steel, covering 95% of the reinforcing steel bars in a key tunnel of Westlake 66 project in Hangzhou. Supplied by a Chinese steel manufacturer, the steel combines renewable energy and recycled steel scrap to cut carbon emissions by 50% compared to conventional alternatives. This initiative advances the company's leadership in sustainable construction, following its earlier use of low carbon emissions steel in the Pavilion Extension of the flagship Plaza 66 in Shanghai. Altogether, the company has procured almost 2,700 tonnes of low carbon emissions steel in Shanghai and Hangzhou projects in 2024 and 2025, achieving a combined 45% emissions reduction. Hang Lung remains committed to steel decarbonisation through responsible procurement and active involvement in a real estate steel sector collaborative initiative.



Henderson Land partnered with fellow BEC member CLPe in enhancing sustainability at Manulife Financial Centre through a cooling solution. Riding on the success of the first partnership to launch Cooling as a Service at Flora Plaza in Fanling back in 2023, which achieved significant energy savings, the team has extended the initiative to Manulife Financial Centre, a prime Grade A office tower in East Kowloon. The solution features Al-powered platform that optimises chiller performance in real time. With more than 60% of energy efficiency improvement, it is expected to reduce energy consumption by more than 30%.



To celebrate National Ecology Day 2025, the Green Hong Kong Green programme, co-organised by **HK Electric** and a local NGO, presented a special Night Safari at Tai Tam Country Park and Lamma Island, inviting the public to explore Hong Kong's nocturnal biodiversity. Nearly 20 new arrivals joined the tour, experiencing nature's own "ecological symphony" of frogs, insects, and birds. Rare species such as the Romer's Tree Frog and Hong Kong Newt were spotted. The event helped new residents connect with nature and foster community inclusion. The theme this year, "Lucid Waters and Lush Mountains are Invaluable Assets," highlights the importance of ecological conservation and sustainable development. The programme continues to promote harmony between people and nature.

The "Best Green Shipping Line" award recognises the ocean liner that outperformed its peers in several areas, such as compliance with regulations and environmental standards, investment in green initiatives, strategic planning, emissions reduction policies, and ongoing staff training. This marks the third time OOCL has received this award, demonstrating the market recognition of OOCL's efforts and its resolute commitment to achieving environmental excellence and sustainability.

Towngas has advanced from AA+ to the top-tier AAA, achieving the best overall score among Hong Kong utilities industry constituents and reinforcing its industry leadership. The partnership will also boost climate resilience and reliability of the fixed electrical installations and cooling systems for older buildings through enhanced routine inspections and comprehensive assessments, improving the energy efficiency, climate resilience, and sustainability of properties managed by Kai Shing. **Click here to learn more**



Great Eagle Group has reached a milestone in its 2030 sustainability roadmap by deploying AI to optimise operations across its Hong Kong portfolio, including Great Eagle Centre and Three Garden Road. The pilot enhanced a 7,150 RT chiller plant across 1.6 million square feet, delivering 6.1% energy savings (435,000 kWh annually), reducing 287,000 kg of carbon emissions, and achieving full payback within six months. The initiative sets a benchmark for scalable, smart decarbonisation in real estate.



HAECO recently hosted a visit to a paper recycling facility, where staff gained valuable insights into Hong Kong's unique recycling business and the collaborative efforts behind building a more sustainable community. Inspired to take action, HAECO partnered with the facility on a week-long trial to recycle used hand paper towels in toilets, successfully diverting 160 kg of paper waste from landfills. Used hand paper towels are ideal for recycling as their brief two-second usage keeps them clean and in good condition. Beyond waste reduction, the programme raises staff awareness of paper consumption and fosters recycling habits, reinforcing HAECO's commitment to its sustainable development target of diverting 65% of waste from landfill by 2030.


